THE DIRT ON CONSTRUCTION

Copper Valley Telecom is making significant progress in the 2023 construction season. We are rapidly advancing the Fiber-to-the-Home project on the Tok Highway, approaching the 13-mile mark. Dedicated crews are currently splicing and connecting Grizzly to Tiekel, including the Willow Lake area and extending northward. We are also converting the Kenny Lake area to fiber, improving connectivity and

services. On June 13th, crews initiated Fiber-to-the-Home work in Valdez, focusing on the transition from copper to fiber at Deep Lake.

CVT is also enhancing our wireless network. RINA upgrades are underway from Naked Island to Cordova, with another crew heading from Chistichina to Slana. A clearing crew is preparing sites for four

services. On June 13th, crews initiated towers, streamlining future construction and Fiber-to-the-Home work in Valdez, focusing expansion.

We appreciation the support and patience of all our customers during the construction season, and we are committed to delivering reliable, high-speed connectivity and building connections that matter.


