WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THE BROADBAND REVAMP

At Copper Valley Telecom, we're excited to announce the completion of our Broadband Revamp project, a major upgrade to our telecommunications infrastructure.

Previously, our network depended on a single Internet headend in Valdez, which created challenges during fiber cuts or equipment failures outside our network, leading to service interruptions. To improve reliability, we've added a second Internet distribution point in Glennallen, connected to a secondary upstream provider via alternate routes to the Lower 48. This dual-headend setup greatly reduces the risk of disruptions.

To benefit fully from these enhancements, customers with older

equipment will need to upgrade. Those with outdated ONTs will receive a new Calix ONT at no cost, while customers using SmartRG gateways, which reached their end-of-life in December 2022, should upgrade to AURORA Wi-Fi equipment to enjoy the new network redundancy.

Customer's in need of these equipment upgrades, recently recieved a letter in the mail notifying them.
